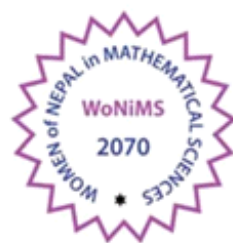

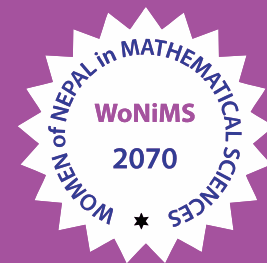

Women of Nepal in Mathematical Sciences (WoNiMS) was created by a group of women faculties engaged in teaching mathematics at different higher institutions with the encouragement, support, and guidelines of senior Professors of mathematics and announced at the program "One-day Seminar on Mathematical Sciences in Nepalese Context" organized by CSC (Council, Society, Center) on December 28, 2013, at Denish Hall of Padmakanya Multiple Campus of Tribhuvan University.

It acts as a platform for women in mathematics research and the teaching profession to share their knowledge, skills, and experiences among themselves. Also, acts as a community of practice for their professional growth and academic development. WoNiMS now has 50 members including 11 executive members, one international committee for WoNiMS and advisory board.

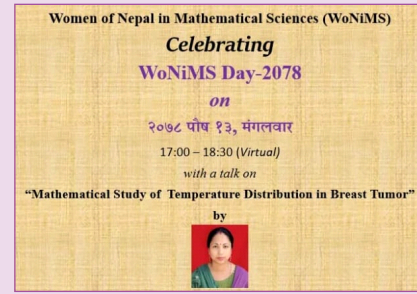
Celebration of Noticeable Days of Mathematics and Women in Mathematics

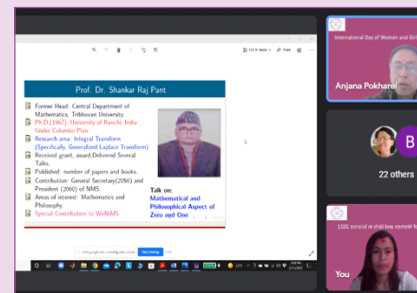

May 12 initiatives is the day to remember the Field Medalist 2014, and Iranian Women mathematician Maryam Mirzakhani (May 12, 1977-- July 14, 2017) for her contribution to the field of Algebraic geometry. It is a kind of promotional program on women and mathematics activities.
